#### **Mission Statement**

AEMGO is committed to the fostering of community amongst graduate students within ASE/EM with an added emphasis on connecting our department with the broader STEM graduate community on campus. Additionally, AEMGO works to aid prospective and current ASE/EM graduate students seeking information and resources relevant to qualifying exams, coursework, advisors, departmental relations, research, and industry.

#### Membership

All Aerospace Engineering and Engineering Mechanics graduate students (M.S. and Ph.D.) will automatically gain membership to this organization. There will be no annual fees/dues.

#### Leadership

The organization shall be governed by a team of graduate students (under the jurisdiction of the department). This team shall comprise of:

- **President:** Set direction, work with the department, and ensure responsibilities are met
- Vice President: Stand-in for President, and be the 2<sup>nd</sup> in command and responsibility
- Treasurer: Monitor expenditures, submit reimbursement forms, and place purchases
- Social Coordinator: Announce events, maintain website, and create flyers/event pages
- Logistics Officer: Create orders, maintain student organization room, and ensure supplies

## **Election Procedure**

- Elections open on the 14<sup>th</sup> of September
- Candidates use the Google Drive link below to submit an application, which includes a photo of themselves and a paragraph or two about them and why they should be elected
- Applications will close by 11:59 on the 30<sup>th</sup> of September
- A Google form will be sent out with the candidates listed and the application form folder linked. Candidates will be voted on with a ranked-choice voting system. Links explaining ranked-choice voting and the template of the Google form are below.
- Voting will close at 11:59 on the 14<sup>th</sup> of October
- From the ranked-choice voting, the 1st elected candidate will get the 1st choice of officer position, and so on with each consecutive elected candidate, until all positions are filled.
